**Resolution No. 628: Continuous Membership for Former Prisoners of War
Origin: Texas
Submitted By: Convention Committee on Internal Organization**

WHEREAS, There were many members of The American Legion who were prisoners of war during the war just completed; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, By The American Legion in National Convention assembled in San Francisco, California, September 30, October 1, 2, 3, 4, 1946, That dues be waived for their period of captivity for members of The American Legion who were prisoners of war and who could not continue their dues during their captivity and that they be given a right to request continuous membership.
