**Resolution No. 7: No Fundamental Difference or Conflict Between the Constitutions,
By-Laws, Offices, Resolutions and Policies of The American Legion and the American
Legion Auxiliary**

RESOLVED, By the National Executive Committee of The American Legion in regular meeting assembled in Indianapolis, Indiana, on May 19–20, 1923, That there can be no fundamental difference or conflict between the constitutions, by-laws, offices, resolutions and policies of The American Legion and the American Legion Auxiliary, but that the Legion provisions shall cover any instance of such difference or conflict, and the conflicting Auxiliary provisions shall be deemed unconstitutional.
